**** Background ****

Swachh Bharat Mission is an initiative by the Government of India to create a clean India and promote environmental sustainability. **Adamyia Chetana**, a NGO founded in the year 1997, is involved in providing hot and nutritious meals to over 2 lakh children every day under the Mid Day Meal Scheme through it's 5 kitchens across cities. Adamyia Chetana has pioneered and implemented very successfully the concept of **Green Kitchen** at Bengaluru for the last 5 years. Today, the Bengaluru kitchen cooks food for nearly 50,000 children daily without generating a speck of garbage (solid and liquid), and use of fossil free fuel only.
